Apply today for rental housing in Maple Ridge

BC Housing is accepting rental applications for Turnock Manor, a brand-new building at 22325 St. Anne Avenue in Maple Ridge.

64 units are available for move in starting in November 2021, providing rental housing for low- to moderate-income earners. Turnock Manor will provide a mix of studio, one- and two-bedroom homes at a fair market rent.

Applications will be considered from current residents of British Columbia with a preference given to those who work in Maple Ridge or neighbouring communities.

What is fair market rent?

The rents at Turnock Manor have been set below comparable market rents in the area. Under the Provincial Rental Supply Program, units must be rented to households with income below an established limit. Applicants must also demonstrate an ability to pay established market rents. There are no subsidies available; however, some households may be eligible for assistance with their rent through other BC Housing programs such as the Shelter Aid for Elderly Renters (SAFER) or Rental Assistance Programs.
