Emergency Shelter & Housing for the Homeless

9,150 homeless individuals assisted including:

- › 2,610 shelter spaces to serve the homeless
- › 5,530 homeless housed
- › 1,010 homeless rent supplements

Transitional Supportive & Assisted Living

19,070 individuals assisted including:

- › 6,480 people with special needs
- › 11,860 frail seniors
- › 730 spaces to serve women and children fleeing violence

Independent Social Housing

40,940 households assisted including:

- › 21,020 low-income seniors
- › 19,920 low-income families

Rent Assistance in the Private Market

26,290 low-income households assisted including:

- › 15,960 seniors
- › 10,330 families

Private Market Rentals
