# Request for Proposals – Rent Supplements

## Private Operators and Non-Profit Societies Richmond

BC Housing, in partnership with **Vancouver Coastal Health**, has issued a call for proposals to non-profit societies and private operators interested in providing assisted living through the Independent Living BC (ILBC) rent supplement program.

Specifically, the call is for the provision of a minimum of 10 ILBC units in the Richmond area, however a proposal of 40 units is preferred. Sites in central, north east or north west Richmond will be given preference.

ILBC offers tenants self-contained apartments along with personal care and hospitality services such as two meals daily, weekly housekeeping and some laundry, social and recreational opportunities, and a 24-hour response system.
