Fact Sheet (September 2023)

The Province recently announced its <u>Homes for People</u> action plan, which builds upon the 2018 housing strategy and includes funding for BC Housing to create 67,000 affordable homes for individuals, seniors, families, women, and people experiencing, or at risk of. homelessness.

Funding programs for these homes include the Community Housing Fund (CHF), the Indigenous Housing Fund (IHF), the

Women's Transitional Housing Fund (WTHF), and the Supportive Housing Fund (SHF), which will be available in the coming months for interested applicants.

BC Housing will be issuing calls for proposals for four funding programs:

Community Housing Fund (CHF)

- For families, seniors, persons with disabilities, low/medium income individuals
- Target >20,000 units by 2031/32
- Program timing: Fall 2023



Indigenous Housing Fund (IHF)

- For low income Indigenous households
- Target 3,500 units by 2031/32
- Program timing: Fall 2023



Women's Transitional Housing Fund (WTHF)*


- For women and their children leaving violence
- Target 3,000 units by 2031/32
- Program timing: Rolling intake



- For people experiencing or at risk of homelessness
- Target 5,700 units by 2031/32
- Program timing: Rolling intake

- Applicants MUST use the templates provided by BC Housing to be considered


