

## **Katherine McParland Bursary**

Please use this application form only for the **\$1,000 Katherine McParland Bursary Award**. Students are encouraged to apply for all awards for which criteria are met but must submit a complete and separate application package for each award.

Katherine McParland was a passionate and respected advocate for youth experiencing homelessness. As a former youth in foster care, Katherine spent her career fighting tirelessly to create youth-specific housing. This award in memory of Katherine assists young adults (18-25) who have experienced housing instability and who are pursuing an education in social work or community services.

Students must be registered as a full-time (60% course load). Awards will be applied to the upcoming fall semester attended during September of the application year and may not be deferred. Students who do not register or subsequently change to on-leave status will have their award rescinded. Registration confirmation will be required.
