



Solace Shelter (1055 Glenfair Drive)

Site work for the 40-bed Solace Shelter is underway. In April, modular units will be craned onto the site. We currently expect to finish construction and open the Solace Shelter in summer 2026. The Mustard Seed will manage and operate the 24/7, year-round shelter that would support seniors and older adults.

Glenfair Senior Redevelopment – Phase 1 (1100 Glenfair Drive)

The Glenfair Senior Redevelopment is moving forward through the design and development phase. Large projects like this take time. In late 2025, tenants from an older building at the end of its lifespan were supported to move into new homes. BC Housing and Interior Community Services worked together to ensure everyone moved to safe and suitable housing.

Kamloops Complex Care Housing (1102 Glenfair Drive)

To prepare for the 20-unit Kamloops Complex Care Housing (CCH), site preparation and demolition work will begin in spring 2026. The new address for the subdivided parcel is 1102 Glenfair Drive. This parcel was formerly part of 1100 Glenfair Drive. BC Housing will choose an experienced nonprofit organization through a competitive public process. This group will run the building and support the residents. When the group is chosen, we will contact neighbours to introduce them. Interior Health will give extra health supports to people living at CCH. By working together, we want to improve the health and wellbeing of residents and the whole community.

BC Builds Middle Income Rentals – Phase 1 (535 Columbia Street)

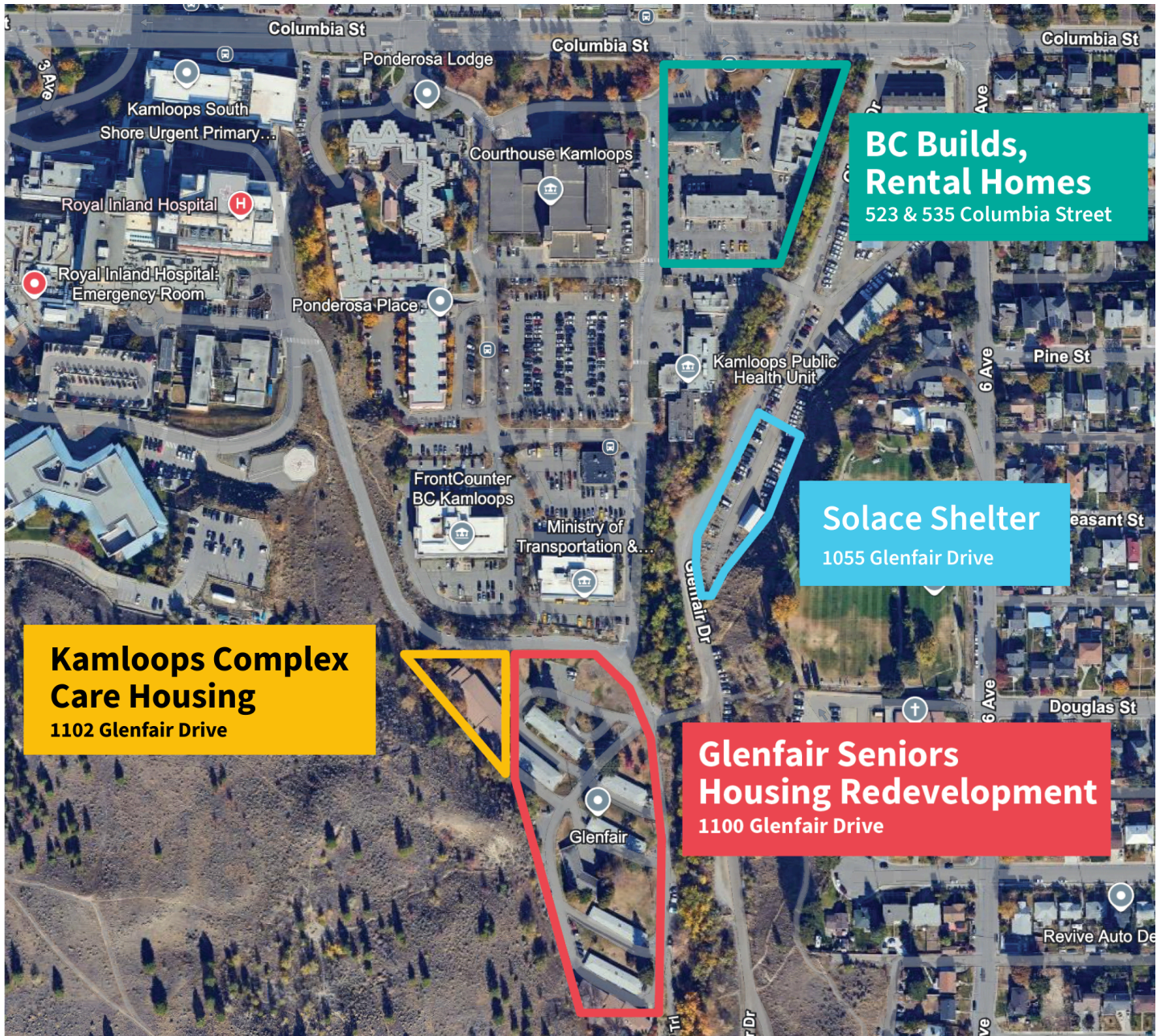
Site work for this BC Builds project is underway. This work will prepare the site for Phase 1 of a 126-home rental project for middle-income households.
