The Complex Care Program supports people who face significant mental health and substance use and/or medical challenges that result in difficulty finding and maintaining a home.

It is housing that provides ongoing care through a variety of health services and supports, all within a home environment.

Services are person-centred. Depending on the individual's needs, services will include things like:



Team-based primary care



Psychiatry



Counselling



Overdose prevention and education



Addiction medicines



Access to Indigenous cultural support

Individuals living in these homes are adults 19 and older



Complex care housing has 24/7 staff

who get to know the individuals and their needs so they can support them with comprehensive, person-centred care.



A new 20-unit building will be built. It will be specifically designed to meet the needs of the people who will live there.

There will be a separate road access and the property will be fenced off.
