Pathways | 142 Tranquille Road, Kamloops

Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to share that Pathways, the shelter and access hub at **142 Tranquille Road in Kamloops**, will be opening in the coming weeks. This shelter will be open year-round providing a much-needed space for up to 44 people. This shelter is a response to the urgent need to support people who are experiencing or are at risk of homelessness in Kamloops.

In late November, City Council voted on and approved a Temporary Use Permit for this site. Final renovations and upgrades to the site are in process and must be completed before we begin welcoming guests. The renovations include the addition and installation of amenity spaces, laundry, storage, fencing, controlled access, enhanced lighting, and security cameras. As well as the completion of fire life system enhancements. Pathways is currently expected to open by late January 2025.

About the shelter

ASK Wellness Society will operate Pathways and provide on-site services to guests, as well as providing access to health, housing, and community resources. ASK Wellness Society is a local charitable non-profit organization with a long history of delivering effective outreach, housing, health, and employment services in the region.
