

# SUPPORTIVE HOUSING IN VANCOUVER



BC Housing and the City of Vancouver are taking collective action to address the urgent need for supportive housing in Vancouver.



## New warm, safe homes with supports on Renfrew Street at East 14th Avenue



Vancouver is in a housing crisis and more than 2,000 people across the city are experiencing homelessness. Creating warm, safe homes with supports continues to be a top priority for BC Housing and the City of Vancouver.

BC Housing, Lu'ma Native Housing Society and the City of Vancouver are proposing to build a new 12-storey building with 76 supportive homes at 2930 Renfrew Street. This proposal replaces an earlier version to build a six-storey building with 50 supportive homes that was shared with the community in June 2021.

These homes would address the urgent need for supportive housing and prevent people from experiencing homelessness.

- All units would be studio apartments with a private bathroom and kitchen.
- At least 5% of the homes would be fully accessible.
- The building would include space for Indigenous cultural practices as well as amenities like shared laundry, commercial kitchen, dining area and program space.
